



Location and Access

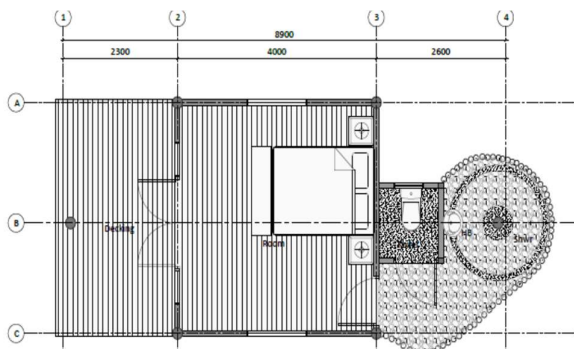
Barefoot Kuata resort is located on Kuata Island, the most southerly island in the Yasawas and closest to Nadi & Denarau. The resort is serviced daily by South Sea Cruises/Awesome Adventures Fiji's ferry service departing from Port Denarau with connections from other Yasawa properties. Private transfer options include seaplane and helicopter.

Climate

Tropical climate with average daily temperatures around 32°C (92°F) in Spring/Summer (Sep-Feb) and average daily temperatures around 27°C (82°F) in Autumn/Winter (Mar-Aug). Due to its westerly location The Yasawas has the lowest rainfall in Fiji.

Accommodation 4 Styles

Beachfront Bure 4 units another 10 under construction. Stunning waterfront location with private beach access. Bures (Fijian for room) are spacious. Bedrooms are fan cooled with queen beds measuring 15.6m² with total bure 35.6m² including shower under the star's bathroom and private shaded decking area. Maximum capacity 2 adults 3 children.

Garden Bure 3 units. Still close to the beachfront with sea views from doorway. Bures (Fijian for room) as are spacious. Bedrooms are fan cooled with queen bed measuring 30m². Maximum capacity 2 adults 3 children.



Safari Double Bure 4 units. Basic, fan cooled, very large room measuring an impressive 24m² plus a private deck area.

Dining and Bar



Dining operates under a mandatory a daily 'Resort Package' fee of FJ\$119 per day per for adults and FJ\$60 per day for children. This includes breakfast, lunch & dinner, Wi-Fi access and use of non-motorised water sports (excludes diving). Breakfast and lunch are buffets with an a la carter dinner.



The restaurant bar area is handcrafted inspired by indigenous Fijian design and architecture. Impressive views look over the pool area out to the sea, with the Fijian islands of Wayalailai and Waya in the background.

Activities & Experiences

There are marked walking tracks around Kuata Island, some offering spectacular stunning views of the Yasawa islands and the surrounding waters. Snorkelling equipment, kayaks, stand up paddles boards and scheduled daily activities e.g. Fijian Medicine Walk are offered for all houseguests. Barefoot Kuata offers exceptional marine activities and is renown for its snorkelling with sharks experience.



The resort has a dive shop offering popular introductory dives, certified dives and SSI open water dive courses. A highlight for introductory divers and certified divers is the 'Awakening Shark Dive'. This new age shark dive with a focus on diver safety and conservation offers an exhilarating dive experience. It's the only open water big shark dive experience where non-certified divers can participate.



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
